UNACCOUNTABLE contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, bided time until nearing the five-sixteenths pole, gained a bit of ground when released from a firm hold, found room to angle into the two path entering the stretch, took off a with a good burst of energy, altered course, full of run, just prior to reaching the heels of a rival lying just up ahead, continued his rally, now placed to that foe's outside, without missing a beat, drew alongside the leader in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, soon went by and edged away under brisk hand encouragement. TANGLED TANGO broke outward a bit, was grabbed hold and pulled off an opponent, leaving the gate in the opposite direction, settled off the leader, bided time until late on the far turn, was given his cue and out raced CODEWORD for the three path, squeezing his way into there as the field headed for the stretch, continued onward willingly and wrested away the lead by the eighth pole, dug in well, failed to keep pace with the top one in the late stages, but had plenty left to procure the place. UNBRIDLED HEAT reserved near the inside for the opening three-quarters, commenced to rally from the five path at the head of the stretch and came home with good energy to take the show. GOOD PROSPECT rated prompting the pacesetter from the outside until the three-sixteenths pole, got out finished. CODEWORD (IRE) three wide around both turns, weakened. SENIORS PRIDE rated along the inside until upper stretch, faltered. HOPPSEY off the inside, was outrun.
