### Footnotes

WHO'S ON THE CASE away well from the starting gate, was lightly coaxed along to keep within range off a spirited pace dispute, dropped back slightly between calls, before narrowing the gap late on the turn, swung three wide for the stretch run and went after the embattled pair in earnest, gained ground readily, drew alongside the surviving pace combatant near the sixteenth pole, successfully wore down that weakening rival in short order, then off the late-closing runner up to preserve the decision. OUTLAW CODY Z bumped with MISS GRIEVANCE at the start, was then steadied and taken in hand a few strides later when WHO'S ON THE CASE crossed over, raced well back for the opening stages, began to pick up pace nearing the end of the turn, kicked into full gear after settling into upper stretch, altered course inward at the eighth pole for better racing room, displayed strong late foot en route for the place. PAM'S LUCKY LADY broke on top, was joined by MISS GRIEVANCE from the rail after completing a furlong, raced on nearly even terms before shaking free in upper stretch, didn't have enough left to stave off the top one with about a sixteenth to go, as well as the runner up shortly afterwards, but still held well nonetheless for show honors. MONEY MAGNET urged from the get-go, left the rail coming to the quarter pole and rallied for the last major award. MISS GRIEVANCE bumped with the runner-up, was urged along and advanced along the rail to contest the pace with PAM'S LUCKY LADY, battled hard with that opponent, being asked for a bit more than that one all the while, started losing contact nearing the furlong marker, was noticeably shortening stride a sixteenth late and steadily tired thereafter. BAYSHORE GAL had no rally. IMAGINE TOMORROW three wide, tired and was eased from the eighth pole to the wire.
