Footnotes

CENTRINA was unhurried off the inside down the backstretch, left the backstretch three wide and began to pick up interest, was briefly in the overland route midpoint on the second turn, turned for home, three wide again, was asked for a three response, sitting in a good striking position, drew on nearly even terms with the runner up as the stretch battle commenced in earnest, fought gamely, with only the slimmest of margins separating the two combatants, and went on to prevail over an equally game opponent. SHAKEIRA three wide at the half mile pole, gradually ranged up to the leader during the run around the second bend, issued a challenge for the front as the field headed for the top of the lane, left the three-sixteenths pole on nearly even terms with the top one, remained so the rest of the way, having to settle for the place, in a game effort nonetheless. VICTORYAT LAST reserved off the inside for six furlongs, was urged three wide into the lane and came home willingly for third. CATCHAPENNY K. took the inside route around the far turn, angled outward at the quarter pole and rallied well enough for the final major share. NURSE DOLCE forwardly placed while between rivals until the quarter pole, weakened late. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE tracked the front runners from the inside, was asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. BEAUTIFUL RISK raced along the outside and was outrun. MY SNOOKIE'S PAL vied for the lead along the rail, was let out at three-eighths pole, remained a prominent factor until upper stretch before backing away. VICTORIA POOL pressed the leader from the outside for three-quarters, had just been asked for some run when he stopped abruptly, was eased, pulled up just prior to the wire, and walked off the course.
