KARMA POLICE out slightly leaving the gate, made light contact with the nearest foe yet broke on top, soon assumed the role of stalker, pressed the issue from the two path, moved up gradually on the turn and poked a head down in front as the pair of front runners arrived at the quarter pole, with the runner up in the midst of a sustained rail run, put away the former pacesetter for good a sixteenth down the road, then held off the last remaining stretch threat, driving. SILVER OVER GOLD tucked along the inside down the backstretch, scurried into contention with a rail rally around the turn, was angled out after settling into upper stretch, failed to make any additional headway on the winner on her way to being second best. CRESCENT SHORE four wide departing the backstretch, held on for the show. LENDERS WAY lightly bumped at the start, raced three wide for most of the way around the bend, had no rally. ALISON'S WYN out hustled leaving the starting gate, raced from off the rail and was outrun. MY GIRL GRACIE went by KARMA POLICE to take over the lead a short distance out of the gate, was gradually guided over to the rail, making it there in time for the run around the bend, got put to the test by the aforementioned rival nearing the quarter pole and yielded, appeared choppy-gaited in upper stretch while dropping back steadily, was eased and dismounted just past the wire, then was vanned off.
