Footnotes

BLUEMBER took the inside route proceeding down the backstretch, slipped into the two path upon reaching the turn, bided time, with the rider atop with a snug grip on the reins, found a seam between rivals and squeezed through to initiate an advance towards the front runners, angled three wide into the stretch, rider still sitting somewhat chilly and in stark contrast with the driving tactics now being applied by the leader at this juncture, went a few strides into the stretch drive before finally being asked for some run, emerged from the furlong grounds in control, edged away, crossing the wire, hand urged. CREPUSCOLO attended the pacesetter from the outside, made a successful bid to grab away the lead in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, was set down to a drive just prior to the quarter pole, with the eventual winner having made his presence felt, yielded when unable to keep pace during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward willingly to secure second. VOTER along the outside, was set down to a hard drive at the half mile pole, proved no match for the top twosome. VENTURA BAR underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. RALLY POINT off the inside, tired. EL CORRIENTE was lightly hand urged to become the early leader, gradually moved closer towards the rail, got confronted and displaced by the second place finisher midway around the turn, began an abrupt retreat by the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home under a protective hold and was eased.
