MAGGIE'S HADDER came inward slightly leaving the starting gate, moved up into a forward position, travelled in the three path for the run around the bend, picked up interest when let out a notch at the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch and got set down to much stronger handling, had all but made up the deficit by the furlong marker, drove past the runner up soon afterwards and kicked clear, finishing the race under brisk encouragement. NONNO'S BOY worked his way to the front after the break, carved the pace while riding the rail, arrived at the quarter pole and got called upon, saw the margin cut into steadily by the top one, surrendered just past the eighth pole, but continued onward to be easily second best. KELTIC FIGHTER took the inside route for nearly a half, was under urging angling four wide into upper stretch, went on to best the rest. SILENT THUNDER was taken hold a few strides out of the gate, reacting to some pressure coming from the outside, departed the backstretch from the four path, remained out there, the widest of all during the ensuing quarter, tired after entering the stretch. TOMMY KARAKORUM under steady urging chasing the leader from the outside, was through by the quarter pole.
