BIG BUSINESS unhurried from off the rail for the opening half, was put into the three path and let out leaving the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch, fought with the rider the entire length of the stretch trying to lug in the whole time, had the rider primarily apply strong pressure on the right rein to counteract this inclination, went by the leader in the final seventy yards and kicked away. N. F.'S DESTINY broke well and after racing on even terms with WEE FREUDIAN briefly, shook free, tucked along the rail once sufficiently in the clear, this happening at the nine-sixteenths pole, cut the pace without facing any resistance, completed the opening half and was soon asked for a response, left the eighth pole without yet a rival having latched on, got reeled in by the top one well past the sixteenth marker and had to settle for the place. WEE FREUDIAN rode the rail to the quarter pole, was angled out and failed to make any significant headway. THE TRUTH AND K G guided over to the rail and set down at the three-eighths pole, showed some belatedly foot to secure the last major check. SCHOOLYARD DREAMS underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn and had no rally. CONSOLE bobbed slightly after losing his footing at the break, chased the leader two wide slightly more than a half and gave way. ESCROW KID off the inside, tired. SAM SPARKLE three wide at the top of the turn, was outrun. WILD TARGET guided quickly towards the inside route after the start, was through after going a half.
