OUT OF FASHION was rated along early, rallied wide, finished determinedly outside and was along late, driving. PRIVATELY HELD raced close up early, rallied three wide and stayed on gamely to the finish. QUILLED BID contested the pace while three wide and stayed on gamely through the stretch. LE MISTRAL raced inside and finished well. ROMAN THUNDER was bumped at the start, put in a four wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. PREMIER KRISCHIEF came wide for the drive and had no rally. RAINING STONES raced inside and had no rally. TORNADIC was pinched back at the start and raced wide. CLEARLY SUNNY was bumped at the start, contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. FROSTY COY was bumped at the start and tired after showing brief speed.
