WILLSHEFIRE raced close up along the inside while in hand, came wide into the stretch, responded when roused and ran away late under a drive. BABY GRAY raced close up along the inside, rallied into the stretch and finished well inside. TAX CONSIDERATIONS showed speed outside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and tired in the final furlong. STAG DANCER was outrun early, raced wide throughout and was going well late. HOLY TROUBLE raced wide throughout and had no rally. GO NATIVE had no rally. SKIPPER TALE tired after a half mile. PENSION was outrun early, raced inside and was steadied in traffic in the stretch. DIAMOND JANE raced inside and was steadied in traffic in the stretch.
