Footnotes

MY SUNSHINE GAL took up a forward position soon after the break, was rated from the outside stalking the pacesetter, continued along on the same scenario for nearly six furlongs, turned for home and was put to encouragement, worked her way past the leader to emerge from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, then edged away under a vigorous hand ride to the wire. CALMAFTERTHESTORM under a snug hold, made the front shortly before completing a quarter of a mile, set the pace, well rated from the inside and with the top one very much in presence, parked just off her hind quarters, was asked for run leading the field into the stretch, yielded to the winner soon afterwards, but held well to procure the place. DECENNIAL settled along the inside during the initial stages, contently tracked the front runner taking the inside route, bided time from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, with the rider aboard with a firm hold on the reins, picked up speed when released from it and spun into the lane two wide, attempted to reel in the top pair but wasn't up to the task. MY DONNA JEAN three wide departing the chute, left the backstretch three wide as well, stayed within range throughout the run around the second bend, entered the stretch being urged but could make no headway on the front runners. SARAFINA raced along the outside, was asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. RED TO POSITIVE sluggish leaving the gate, was never a menace. SHIRTSLEEVES a forward early factor, became rank shortly before reaching the three-quarter pole, was grabbed hold and taken back, raced off the inside thereafter and tired.
