**Footnotes**

NO THREE WORDS pressed inside until shaken off at the three eighths while unasked, had the vying pair up front edge away, came under urging and shifted to the three path in response at the quarter pole, took command just past the three-sixteenths pole, edged away through the lane kept busy to the end. SALVAR bumped at the start by YOUWONTSEEME who broke outwards, raced towards the rear early on in the two path, was checked briefly at the nine-sixteenths when in a bit tight, came under urging near the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, showed good energy through the latter portions of the stretch to garner the place honors. PRIZEMM exchanged bumps at the start, ranged up three wide at the seven-sixteenths to engage the front, vied through the turn initially in the three path and then from the two path when able to clear NO THREE WORDS in tandem with COMITY, was set down at the head of the lane, got displaced just past the three-sixteenths, ran on well appearing to try to lug in a bit near the eight pole before continuing on holding well for the show. PRINCESS REYANA exchanged bumps at the start, chased the front while four wide through the turn, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. ROUGH WINTER settled at the rear, came under a long drive from the three-eighths and never reached a challenging position. COMITY was briefly in hand at the start, sped to the front soon after, got confronted at the seven-sixteenths and vied for command through the turn along the inside, was set down at the head of the lane, remained prominent until the final furlong and tired. YOUWONTSEEME broke out at the start brushing the gate and bumping SALVAR, raced inside towards the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, lost ground through the remainder of the turn and was eased at the head of the lane then walked off under her own power.
