Footnotes

SURFRIDER (IRE) assumed a forward post soon after the start, contested the pace from the two path, with the slightest of hand urging on the reins to maintain interest, narrowed in throughout the run around the bend, reached the quarter pole on dead even terms with LITTLE NICK and got put to some encouragement, scampered away to a comfortable advantage by midstretch, maintained all of it, completing the last eighth under a confident hand ride. KARAKORUM LEGEND underwent a four wide pursuit, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, couldn't dent the winner's margin while second best. AWAKINO CAT settled into midpack after the break, was steadied while in tight quarters in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, tipped into the three path soon afterwards, stayed within striking distance, came up empty when called upon turning for home. NON STOP under a snug hold while sitting a loose pocket down the backstretch, faltered. FASTEST MAGICIAN raced along the outside and was outrun. LITTLE NICK got off sharply to out break the field, tucked along the inside in short order, had the top one draw alongside early on the turn, argued for command with that rival until the quarter pole, was left behind seemingly in a flash once the winner was let out and steadily tired thereafter.
