MOMENT IN DIXIE came inward leaving the start, but managed to avoid making significant contact with any of the nearest opponents, tucked along the rail soon afterwards, set the fractions, facing some resistance, that being offered by another pair in the two paths directly to the outside, got asked for run having drifted into the two path by the head of the stretch, maintained a clear advantage during the ensuing furlong, started to drifted outward departing the furlong grounds, but held on safely. RESONATING was taken over to the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, tracked the front running trio from there, responded positively when given his cue for the stretch run, altered course outward safely off heels coming to the three-sixteenths pole, was forced to alter course off heels a second time a sixteenth later when the winner began to drift outward, failed to make any headway after finishing the latter maneuver. DRAW IT off the inside, left the three-eighths pole already having asked for a response, out raced FORBIDDEN GIFT to gain entrance from the five path into the stretch, got straightened away and rallied to be a non-threatening third. YOU'RE KIDDING under a good hold from the rider, pressed the issue from between rivals on the turn, tired after entering the stretch. BORN BULLISH placed four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. CRESpano contested the pace as the widest of three for a half, folded. FORBIDDEN GIFT raced from off the inside, was put to early encouragement, lost position to DRAW IT nearing the quarter pole prior to calling it a day, tired steadily from upper to midstretch then was eased.
