Footnotes

THE GREAT BANDINI vied for the front from the two path while in reserve, was let out at the quarter pole with a slim advantage, came out under strong left handed stick work at the three-sixteenths bumping lightly with WAR HITCH and pushing that foe out a lane or so, had the rider return to a hard left handed whip and again came out near the eighth pole all the while heads apart for command, battled on determined coming out a third time nearing the wire bumping and carrying out his rival three additional paths while under heavy left handed work and just held on at the wire. WAR HITCH three wide in close pursuit, was set down at the head of the lane while already head apart for command, got bumped and carried out a path near the three-sixteenths by his dueling stretch foe, fought on heads apart and was bumped sounder and carried out again with a furlong to go, continued with good kick stubbornly getting carried out two to three paths nearing the wire by his shying rival and just missed on the line. TORMENT steadied at the start as SIDE PARTY RALPH broke out and was off a beat slow as a result, sat rated in midpack down along the inside until nearing the top of the stretch, swung four wide at that juncture offering up a mild rally for show honors. DUAL MANDATE void of early speed, settled at the rear, came under coaxing midway on the turn, shifted to the three path at the head of the lane, came home with late energy for the last major share. CASH BEAR vied inside early on, was pushed along nearing the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane and faded. GUDAHAI chased from the two path in midpack, swung five wide for home and never reached a challenging position. SIDE PARTY RALPH broke out at the start and was corrected before any contact could be made, tracked the front from the pocket, shifted to the four path after straightening for home and offered no response. VENGEFUL PRIDE just off the pace in the two path, was set down spinning three wide at the quarter pole and offered little. COBALT RED outrun in the early going, proved no factor. There was a Stewards' Inquiry as well as a claim of foul by the rider of WAR HITCH against the unofficial winner THE GREAT BANDINI for interference in the stretch. After review THE GREAT BANDINI

was disqualified from first and placed second for interference in the stretch run before the result was declared official.
