STAKES New York Stallion Spectacular Bid S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEARS OLD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. By subscription of \$200 due on or before December 1, 2009 or \$1,000 on or before December 1, 2010 or \$5,000 on or before September 1, 2011. \$350 to pass the entry box and an additional \$400 to start. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake on the turf, or three races allowed 2 lbs.; two races or a race on the turf, 4 lbs.; a race, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Seven Furlongs on the main track.).

**Footnotes**

KING KREESA broke alertly and assumed a forward position, took up residence in the two path disputing the pace, came under heavy pressure coming to midpoint on the turn, continued to show the way on a narrow advantage and then got let out, kicked away from the competition, emerging from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, remained well in front under good handling. WESTERN TRYST was taken hold when in a bit tight along the rail early down the backstretch, slipped into the two path and was there for most of the way around the bend, got put to encouragement angling three wide into the stretch, finished willingly for the place. WILD EXPLOIT made contact with DISCO ON leaving the starting gate, raced unhurried while towards the rear of the pack, commenced the stretch run from the two path, got gradually taken outward searching for a better route home while proceeding down the lane, was eventually about five to six wide at the end of the maneuver, finishing with good energy en route for the show. GOODTIME BOY was bumped lightly at the start, sat within midpack for the opening half, came three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. I'LL STAKE U raced three wide around the turn and gave way. SPORTSWRITER got knocked sideways slightly just out of the starting gate, the tail end of a chain reaction caused by the stumbling DISCO ON at the start, argued for command from the rail with the eventual winner, faltered when no able to keep pace after entering the stretch. POWERFUL

INSTINCT was no factor. EXCITING MISSILE chased four wide and tired. DISCO ON came inward after stumbling badly at the start, bumping with the nearest opponent and triggering a series of events that affected another pair as well, raced from off the rail, made a bold run taking the overland route around the turn but could not sustain the move upon reaching the quarter pole. REGGIE D broke slowly, dropped back when slow to settle into stride and was always outrun. SUNNYSIDER displayed brief foot.
