THREE RING broke alertly and prompted the pace while in hand, gained a short lead nearing the stretch, dug in gamely when headed by BETTER THAN HONOUR in midstretch then came again under left handed whipping and prevailed while forcing out BETTER THAN HONOUR in the final yards. BETTER THAN HONOUR raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, advanced three wide on the turn, rallied to earn a short lead past the eighth pole and battled gamely despite being carried out by the winner in deep stretch. MADISON'S CHARM, unhurried while outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and finished gamely from the outside. OH WHAT A WINDFALL raced close up on the rail early on, was roused along the inside on the turn but had no response. SAPPHIRE N' SILK showed in front soon after the start, set the pace while in hand then faded in the stretch. PRECIOSA V. raced wide throughout and lacked a rally with her rider losing his whip in the stretch. T STORM was rated outside, raced very wide through and had no rally. THINGS CHANGE was rated along between rivals and came up empty when asked. After a claim of foul against the winner by the rider of the second place finisher, the result was declared official.
