CENTENNIAL CAT raced wide and had no response when roused. WITH AFFIRMATION raced wide throughout and tired. GRAND I AM had no rally. AU CURRANT was outrun along the inside. BOBBIN tired after a half mile. SHOP AGAIN stumbled after the start, unseating her rider. Following a Stewards' inquiry into the start the result was declared official.
