MS STILLETO moved up along the backstretch, rallied three wide leaving the turn then closed steadily to get up in the final strides. DOE RUN pressed the pace well in hand from outside, gained a slim advantage on the turn, opened a clear lead in midstretch then yielded grudgingly. RHYS raced well back, steadied in traffic between horses midway on the turn, swung five wide and rallied belatedly. VEE trailed to the turn, circled six wide and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. EXCHANGE FUNDS steadied between horses at the five-eighths pole, raced in traffic in the two path on the turn, made a run to reach contention in midstretch and flattened out. SAPPHIRE MINK raced five wide while gaining slightly on the turn and lacked a late response. FORBIDDEN PARADISE (IRE) led on the rail to the turn and gave way. MEHNDI steadied along the rail on the backstretch, raced in tight while saving ground on the turn and gave way. DEPUTY'S CITIZEN saved ground in hand for six furlongs and faltered.
