ONE FORTY patiently stalked the leader from the outside, moved up and bid between rivals coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for run and kicked clear of the two nearest pursuers during the run through the furlong grounds, then held sway under a drive. BUDDYS DREAM rode the rail, searched about for room to vacate the premises from about midpoint on the turn, angled outward eagerly once able to perform the maneuver in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was set down to a hard drive at the quarter pole and rallied with good energy to garner place honors. FELDBERG underwent a three wide pursuit and lacked the necessary stretch response. VOYAGER came inward, bumping with NOW NOW GIRL and eventually herding that opponent into light contact with DONNA'S SANDEE as well, quickly grabbed the lead, cut the pace, well rated from the inside and only loosely-contested, felt some heat for the initial time after completing the half, was let out in response to it turning for home, backed away after leaving the furlong grounds. NOW NOW GIRL was bumped by VOYAGER at the start, got carried in a path or so by the aforementioned rival, resulting in a light bump with DONNA'S SANDEE a couple of jumps later, settled into stride and along the outside, appeared well placed for the stretch drive, got called upon and came up empty. HAPPY HAYA stumbled badly at the start, made a rapid recovery and moved up willingly into a forward position, tracked the front runners from the inside, was asked for some run at the five-sixteenths pole, entered the lane under much stronger handling and tired. DONNA'S SANDEE bumped lightly NOW NOW GIRL a short distance out of the starting gate, was widest of all around the bend and in upper stretch while outrun.
