NINE O WONDERFUL away in good order, sneaked his way into the pocket coming to the turn, rode the rail for a brief distance, was back on the move to the outside just past the three-eighths pole, entered the stretch three wide under encouragement, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, picked up ground more readily thereafter, collared the front runners in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, quickly went and edged away under hand rousing. THE LAURELS quickly took up residence along the inside, was coaxed along to keep pace down the backstretch, was asked for a bit more from midpoint on the turn, followed the winner's move to leave the inside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, got straightened away and fully roused, angled inward off the top one's heels when that opponent drifted out slightly in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, resumed the rally without any significant loss of momentum, got trapped between rivals as he nearly ran up on a foe coming to the sixteenth pole, altered course outward a few strides later and kicked in belatedly to grab the place. MAGNIFI CAT lightly coaxed stalking the leader, crept up to that one during the run around the bend, turned for home having drawn directly to the outside, was asked for a response in unison with the pacesetter, battled hard down the lane but had to settle for the show. SELF CONTROL ducked over to the inside at the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner into the lane under encouragement, was beginning to angle out at the three-sixteenths pole, when suddenly denied the two path by the runner up, was blocked in traffic behind rivals from that station to the sixteenth pole, eventually worked his way outward at the eighth pole, chose not to attempt to split rivals through a narrow seam at that point, was taken outward a second time in deep stretch and flashed belated interest. SHOW TIME on the rail, was coaxed while cutting the pace, got called upon simultaneously with the MAGNIFICAT as that pair headed into the stretch, held his ground stubbornly before weakening in the final sixteenth. CUATRO D'ORO raced along the outside and was through after going a half.
