DANCE MASTER was hustled to the front, set the pace while in hand, drew clear when roused turning for home and was kept busy to the finish. SETTLEMENT, outrun early, advanced nearing the stretch, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished gamely to get the place. BROADWAY BARNEY, hustled along outside, raced wide and finished with good energy. MY BUDDY ROB showed good speed from the start, put in a three wide move into the stretch and continued well to the wire. MCILHENY was hustled up outside, pressed the pace into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. NEGOTIATOR, hustled inside, chased the pace along the rail and lacked a rally. GONE SUPER showed good speed from the start, put in a four wide move approaching the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. TRUELAMAR was hustled from the gate, raced wide and had no response. CALL ME C. J. bobbled at the start and had no rally. KACHEMAK BAY was outrun.
