YAGLI, rated along early, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide for the drive, reached the front approaching the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. FEDERAL TRIAL, taken in hand after an alert break and rated along in the early going, came wide into the stretch and rallied to earn the place. MIDDLESEX DRIVE showed good speed while in hand, went after pacesetter VERGENNES nearing the stretch, gained a short lead between calls in upper stretch but could not handle the winner and was outfinished for the place. PARADE GROUND, rated along outside, raced three wide and offered a mild rally in the stretch. LITE APPROVAL raced inside and lacked a solid finishing punch. DIVIDE AND CONQUER chased outside and weakened in the drive. VERGENNES flashed good speed from the start, set the pace into the stretch and gave way. FAHRIS (IRE) had no response when roused. WISED UP raced close up on the hedge and tired after three quarters. DEVONWOOD was pulled up entering the first turn and was vanned off.
