KASHATREYA, outrun early while racing wide, rallied nearing the stretch and closed relentlessly down the middle of the track and was along in the final yards. ARTAX, pinched back after the start, raced inside early, advanced between rivals nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive, earned a short lead in deep stretch and battled gamely to the wire. THE TRADER'S ECHO, close up outside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely. ORO DE MEXICO was hustled from the outside, pressed pacesetter TEXAS GLITTER into the stretch, earned a short lead in midstretch but weakened late. WOULDNT WE ALL, outrun in the early going, came widest into the stretch and finished with good courage. FLASHING TAMMANY chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. PUNCH LINE chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. TEXAS GLITTER stumbled at the start but quickly showed in front then set the pace into the stretch and tired. MASTER O FOXHOUNDS stumbled badly after the start, dropped far back and was being eased in the stretch.
