



CAT GENIUS flashed good speed from the outside, drew clear into the turn, set the pace and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. POHAVE raced close up while three wide and finished well outside. SING ME BACK HOME was hustled along early, raced inside and finished well inside. CANADIAN FRONTIER was hustled outside, raced three wide and lacked a rally. FIRST BLUSH raced inside and had no response when roused. MAYBRY'S BOY had no rally. BUZZY'S GOLD chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. KEY DEPUTY chased the pace while four wide, tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
