Footnotes

EL TAMBERITO angled in early, saved ground just off the pace for a half, was looking to move out nearing the far turn, waited patiently for room while saving ground on the turn, steadied briefly while trapped inside POCKET COWBOYS at the quarter pole, split horses in upper stretch, took charge nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear under steady urging. POCKET COWBOYS pressed the pace from outside, kept the winner pinned in leaving the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and continued on willingly to hold the place. SOUTH FOURTH ST. saved ground while outrun for a half, swung out nearing the quarter pole then rallied mildly. PUTIN rushed up along the rail, set the pace inside into midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. A ZERO TRAP raced four wide to the top of the stretch, angled to the inside in upper stretch and lacked a late response. STOPBLUFFING was outrun while four wide throughout.
