BRIBON (FR) was taken back under a snug hold soon after the start, trailed the field along the backstretch, rapidly gained while circling five wide inside the quarter pole then closed strongly under a vigorous hand ride in the middle of the track to win going away. SNAPSHOT was rated just behind the early leaders, rallied three wide on the turn, drew on even terms with the pacesetter inside the eighth pole, but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth, while much the best of the others. CHECKLIST was hustled up to gain the early advantage, angled to the inside, shook off a mild challenge at the quarter pole, opened a clear lead in midstretch then weakened under pressure in the final eighth. FORMIDABLE pressed the early pace along the rail, was eased back slightly and moved to the outside at the half mile pole, made a run between horses to threaten at the quarter pole and tired late. ELUSIVE WARNING raced in midpack, advanced three wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. MORE THAN A REASON raced well back along the rail for a half, drifted out in midstretch and faltered. FANTASY FREE failed to mount a serious rally. GATO GO WIN raced five wide for a half and was well in hand while giving way in midstretch.
