BOLD VINDICATION strung out in the four path around the opening bend, stalked the pacesetter a bit closer to the rail down backstretch and around the far turn, sat on hold as the field headed for the stretch, got asked for a response and took off after the leader in earnest, collared that opponent a short distance from the sixteenth pole, needed only a few additional strides to go and crossed the wire under hand encouragement. **WISHINGTONADREAM** quickly established control, was rated along the inside while cutting the fractions, responded positively once given his cue, emerged from the furlong grounds, still the clear leader, offered good resistance before giving way to the winner, but continued on willingly to fend off **TIGER WILLIE** for second. **TIGER WILLIE** commenced his rally four wide from midpoint on the far turn, had a good finish down the center of the course en route for the show. **GAMBLIN FEVER** reserved off the inside for nearly three-quarters, ducked over to the rail just past the three-sixteenths pole and came home willingly for the last major slice of the pot. **TRUE LINNET** saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals a furlong down the road while rallying. **MARKET ANALYSIS** three wide on the first turn, took up residence in the two path soon after settling into the backstretch, prompted the leader until the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor during the ensuing furlong before weakening. **ELDER SKATESMAN** put to a prolonged drive, spun four wide into upper stretch, failed to reach a contending position. **SENIOR ENRICO** three wide around both turns, had no rally. **BERESFORD** tracked the front runners from the inside and faltered.
