VINDA broke the gate prior to the start, was reloaded and proceeded to come away in good order, brought up the back of the pack during the opening half, fanned six wide into the stretch, placed widest of all, took off as if shot out of a cannon, rolling on by the entire field down the lane to prove best. MADRILENA bumped at the start, went on towards the front, engaged in a spirited tussle with EVE OF DESTRUCTION while taking the inside route, fought viciously throughout a grueling opening half, with neither rival willing to concede the other an inch for almost a half, shook free soon after settling into upper stretch, but with a host of fresher opponents bearing down hard, had no answer for the top one as that rival went sailing by, but showed enough determination to reach the finish line in time to preserve the place. BRAMPTON tracked the hotly-contested pace from the inside, launched a rail rally after turning for home, barely missing out for second. SOUNDS FAMILIAR raced along the outside, was coaxed along to keep pace, commenced to rally in earnest five wide at the head of the stretch and displayed a good kick en route for the final major share. TIDAL SLAM was bumped at the start, chased the duelers while racing off the inside, failed to fire appreciably once called upon. EVE OF DESTRUCTION battled hard for command for a half from the two path, tired steadily after going a half. HEY BABE three wide off the speed duel, tired. FUNKY MUNKY MAMA was bumped from both sides leaving the starting gate, recovered and settled into midpack, sat well placed off the pace dispute from the outside, remained in the thick of things until midstretch before backing away.
