**Footnotes**

METRO METEOR was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, rallied wide into the stretch and drew away late. REDEFINED raced close up outside, put in a three wide run nearing the stretch and continued on to be second best. SOUTHERN PRINCE contested the pace from the outside, was steadied in the stretch and tired. THECONFIDENCEMAN was outrun early, raced wide and offered a mild rally outside. STORM N LIGHTNING contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. FEROCIOUS WON had no rally. DIXIE BAGHDAD had no response when roused. SIGH YOU tired after a half mile. MACKLENIN raced three wide and tired. STRUMMER tired badly and was eased in the stretch. A claim of foul against the second place finisher by the rider of the third place finisher, alleging interference in the stretch, was not allowed.
