Footnotes

FIRST WHIPPOORWILL sat reserved in midpack, was taken slightly off the rail upon reaching the full turn, remained under a firm hold by the rider bidding time behind rivals approaching the quarter pole, found room to maneuver turning for home and was angled into the three path, continued onward under her own power for a little while longer before finally being asked for some run, picked up the pace willingly, grabbed away the lead leaving the eighth pole and edged away under good handling. TAKE HER TOTHE TOP three wide on the turn, had a good finish down the center of the course to garner the place. LEA THE PUNISHER patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, ranged up leaving the backstretch, issued a challenge coming to the quarter pole, took over and emerged from the furlong grounds holding a clear advantage but with several others moving willingly and in hot pursuit, got overhauled soon afterwards and eventually weakened into the show slot. G. A. EMPRESS strung out three wide on the elbow chute, took the two path down the backstretch and beyond, spun three wide into the lane, made up some ground during the initial portion of the stretch run, eyed more promising territory inward in

midstretch, and eagerly angled towards the rail, mustered up a mild response afterwards to secure the last major check. THE WEST RIM travelled three wide on the turn, made a run from upper to midstretch but could not sustain the bid. SPEEDY'S GAL lacked the necessary stretch response. ANOTHER PLEASE saved ground until the half mile pole, gradually moved outward leaving that station until three wide a furlong down the road, had no solid closing punch. MOONSHINE MAGIC saved ground until the quarter pole, failed to reach a contending position. TEN K CAT took the inside route, was asked for a response by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. TO THE POINT (ARG) made a three wide run to gain the early lead, showed the way from the inside unopposed, came under pressure late on the turn, gave way.
