Footnotes

WICKAPECKO lightly bumped at the start, assumed a forward position, patiently kept watch on the front runners for slightly more than a half, moved up towards them nearing the end of the bend, spun into the stretch and was asked for her best, narrowed in during the run through the furlong grounds, drifted out willingly, the tail end result of some pressure coming from an errant ALPHA J at this juncture, took over and edged away in the last seventy yards. CORRESPONDENT sat reserved from off the inside, was wedged in between rivals from the five-sixteenths marker to the quarter pole, paused and was taken hold of prior to entering the stretch, got called upon once into it, initiated an attempt to alter course to the outside in midstretch, changed plans once ALPHA J began to drift outward, ducked inward sharply instead, came home with good belated energy to procure the place. ALPHA J hand urged to secure the front, was put to a firm hold after achieving the goal, cut the pace being rated along and feeling the presence of RODINIA parked just off her hind quarters, remained under rating tactics until turning for home, fought with vigor but surrendered, albeit by a slim advantage travelling through the furlong grounds, drifted out slightly taking RODINIA along for a short ride, held well while claiming show honors. RODINIA made light contact with BLUE SIXTY FOUR at the break, pressed the issue from two path, had already been put to some encouragement challenging for command from between rivals turning for home, fought her way to a narrow lead, got herded out a couple of paths from the furlong marker to the sixteenth pole vying to protect it, relinquished for good in deep stretch and backed away. PRECIOUS FRANCA broke near the top, but quickly dropped back towards the rear of the pack, was about four wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the needed response. HEIRESSOFTHECROWN three wide entering the turn, was five wide exiting, came up empty. GUYANA STAR stalked the front runners, kept at a slight distance from off the inside, tired. BLUE SIXTY FOUR bumped from between foes at the start, trailed throughout while taking the inside route.
