Footnotes

TWO MOONS set a solid pace along the inside under very little pressure other than being accompanied on the front, was let out at the quarter pole spinning from the two path, edged away to a safe lead with a furlong remaining, was kept busy thereafter while maintaining her advantage to the wire. HOOPSKIRT away alertly, was content to track the leader along the inside under reserve until nearing the five-sixteenths, got called upon at that station, shifted to the two path at the head of the lane, rallied readily for place honors. SURROUND SOUND broke out slightly at the start and was corrected, sat reserved towards the rear, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home kicking on belatedly for show honors. MISS TEQUILA lightly prompted the pace from the two path early on while forwardly placed, lost ground and position through the turn while patiently unhurried as her rivals came under pressure to pick it up, shifted inside to the rail near the quarter pole put to a drive, rallied by tired foes in the lane. SANTORINI MOON bobbled slightly at the break, made a four wide bid from the seven-sixteenths to the front to move into contention by the five-sixteenths while under a drive, remained prominent until the final furlong when no longer able to sustain the kick and weakened thereafter. PELICAN LAKE three wide in close pursuit, faded after a half. CHALK PLAYER trailed early on, swung three wide for home and was never involved. FIRST PENNY chased while three to four wide throughout, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, offered no response.
