Footnotes

BIG JOHN B sat in midpack while two to three wide well rated, made steady progress on the front under his own power through the turn, awaited options at the head of the lane having no clearance to shift outwards and awaiting the decision of the tiring pace presence, had a seam develop after straightening away, moved on through to engage the leader brushing with LATE STARTER nearing the eighth pole, took command just after the furlong marker and drew clear under a hand ride before being geared down in the final strides. BARRYMORE allowed to settle early on, came under coaxing while three to four wide in the turn at the three-eighths pole, steadily progressed on the front, swung five wide for home, came home with good energy for the place. LATE STARTER three wide in close pursuit, spun four wide for home placed to a drive, brushed with the eventual winner nearing the final furlong, kicked on mildly for show honors in the latter portion of the lane. SANTONIO D'ORO sat between foes in the two path in close range while on hold until the quarter pole, rallied mildly when called upon through the lane to just procure the last major share on the line. MEETING reserved at back, came under a drive at the

five-sixteenths while four wide through the latter portion of the turn, swung five wide for home and rallied by tired foes in the lane just missing the last major share. DENDRITE vied inside given some rein to work with from the get go, cut the corner fully engaged by the rider remaining a forward factor to the final eighth when displaced, steadily faded thereafter. BEACH BOY ALEX briefly in hand after the start, settled towards the rear in the two path, saved ground and made no impact when called upon nearing the head of the stretch. IRON WILLED tracked the pace inside while forwardly placed initially, came under hand urging at the three-eighths pole and steadily faded losing ground and position through the turn, offered no kick through the lane. UPKEEP vied for command while two to three wide, came under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole, remained in contention until the head of the stretch, tired and was not persevered with thereafter. TRANSPLENDENT raced three wide towards the rear and never threatened.
