THE FED EASED argued for the lead while racing along the inside, was let out as the front runners turned for home, edged away, crossing the finish line under a brisk hand urging. CROWN THE CHIEF moved up under a snug hold from the rider to assume a forward position after the start, vied for command two wide around the turn, got shaken off by the winner after entering the stretch but continued onward willingly to garner the place. STAR DANCE M D rode the rail, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner into the lane under a full drive, proved no match for the top twosome. SUN DANCE MOON lacked the needed response. TOM CAT ALLIE chased the ongoing pace dispute from the outside, was between rivals for much of the way around the turn, tired. GREELEY'S LAW raced three wide on the turn, drafted behind FLO'S GREATNESS spinning into the stretch, tipped into five path in upper stretch, failed to gain ground. FLO'S GREATNESS underwent a three wide pursuit, folded.
