**Footnotes**

DIGHTON off the inside in midpack, was given his cue leaving midpoint on the turn, turned for home three wide under solid encouragement, went on a little farther, then altered course into the six path in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole with the runner up following suit, only settling to be slightly wider at that station, was in the middle of an abbreviated three-way scramble for command in the late stages, inched away with the advantage then held on gamely while drifting outward and carrying out HARLEY in the final seventy yards to preserve the decision. HARLEY left the three-eighths pole from the three path, entered the stretch slightly wider, angled outward at the same time the winner did, approaching the three-sixteenths marker, stayed latched on to that rival and advanced towards the front runners, vied outside another pair for control for a few strides in the final stages, got carried out a bit nearing the wire and was ultimately denied. BEDOUIN NOW gave chase from off the inside, was let out a notch from the five-sixteenths pole and angled outward until four wide by the head of the stretch, rallied into contention, flattened out late. RISK MANAGEMENT put to some urging leaving the starting gate, outkicked an equally-hustled LIBERTY WING to secure the front, sat entrenched in the two path rated afterwards until about the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home with several others in hot pursuit, drifted inward during the initial portion of the stretch run, yielded with just under a furlong to go and faltered. LIBERTY WING briskly hand urged towards the inside in the opening stages, got outkicked for the early advantage by RISK MANAGEMENT, got tipped into the three path once the result of the opening pace skirmish had been determined, gave chase on the pacesetter, was sent over to the inside and rode the rail from the three-eighths pole to the end of the bend, angled back to the outside at the top of the lane, scurried in the right direction to be a serious threat with an eighth to go, but with the eventual first three finishers bearing down hard to the outside, failed to sustain the move and backed away. ATTENBOROUGH three wide on the turn, gave way. CRAQUI off the inside, trailed throughout.
