BIG SCREEN away sharply at the start, cut the pace just off the inside in hand, got set down three wide in upper stretch, drifted out two paths despite off sided stick work, got confronted by SOUPER SPEEDY inside the final eighth continued to drift out five additional paths herding that foe out to the wire then bumped soundly with that foe in the final strides and just held on. SOUPER SPEEDY five wide early on coaxed along within range, came under further encouragement three furlongs from home, spun three wide into upper stretch behind the leader, angled out two paths as that foe drifted in front, confronted that one inside the final eighth getting latched on and herded out through to the wire, was bumped soundly in the final strides and just missed. POLITICALLYCORRECT broke out at the start leaning on RELOAD for a few strides out of the gate and squeezing that foe against SOUPER SPEEDY, saved ground at the rear, came under encouragement midway on the turn, offered up a mild kick through the stretch gaining on the drifting pair up front to secure the show well clear of the rest. RELOAD jostled between foes at the start the product of POLITICALLYCORRECT breaking outwards, was forwardly placed three wide within aim of the leader, came under coaxing midway on the turn, faded nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station and weakened in the drive. NEXT QUESTION four wide just off the pace in pursuit, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled five wide in upper stretch and tired. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the first two finishers through the stretch run, as a result BIG SCREEN was disqualified from first and placed second for interfering with SOUPER SPEEDY in deep stretch before the result was declared official.
