BOWMAN'S BAND was taken in hand after the start, was rated along inside, angled out midway on the turn, advanced outside, swung five wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused and drew away under a drive. TEMPLE YARD was hustled to the front, set the pace under constant pressure, could not handle the winner in the final furlong and continued on gamely to best the others. SALTY PRINCE chased the pace while four wide and lacked a rally. OFFICIAL BUSINESS pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. WHOLESALE HARRY was bumped at the start, chased the pace from the outside and tired. TIME CHOPPER chased inside and tired after a half mile. CARIBBEAN CODE was bumped at the start, raced very greenly and tired. MOET MONET chased inside and tired in the stretch. TABOO was outrun.
