### Footnotes

TOO SCARLET broke awkwardly, raced close up inside while in hand, came through on the rail approaching the stretch, drew clear turning for home then dug in gamely and remained clear under a drive. ELLIE'S MOMENT was outrun early, raced between rivals, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. BELLE ARTISTE was unhurried outside early, advanced four wide nearing the stretch, responded when roused and finished gamely. LAURIE'S BALADA raced with the pace while three wide and weakened in the stretch. SASKYA was steadied along the inside on the backstretch, raced on the rail and lacked a closing kick. BEIJIO dropped back early, raced inside and was steadied on the rail in upper stretch. INDY GLORY was outrun early, raced wide and was steadied outside of the spill in upper stretch. QUIET contested the pace along the inside, was forced to be steadied after jumping a fallen rival in upper stretch and dropped back. PLEASANT COUNTY chased the pace while between rivals and fell over a fallen rival in upper stretch. IMADEED contested the pace and broke down and fell in upper stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run the result was declared official.
