Footnotes

GYGISTAR raced close up inside, came wide into the stretch, ran by YANKEE GENTLEMAN in midstretch and drew clear under a drive. DRAW PLAY was outrun early, picked it up when roused along the inside on the turn and finished gamely inside to earn the place award. TRUE DIRECTION raced between rivals early on, came five wide nearing the stretch and lacked a rally while drifted out in the drive. YANKEE GENTLEMAN showed speed from the outside, moved three wide to the front midway on the turn, had no response as the winner ran by in midstretch and tired in the final furlong. AMERICAN STYLE was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. BURNT EMBER dropped back after the start, raced inside and had no rally. WARNERS chased the pace while four wide and tired after a half mile. OUTSTANDER stumbled at the start, was hustled up between rivals, contested the pace for a half mile and tired. DAY TRADER contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
