BEAT HOLLOW (GB) took control of the situation soon after the start, dictated the pace while well in hand, settled into the stretch with a clear lead, left the eighth pole well in front and on his own courage and remained safely clear with his rider waving the whip from the right hand side. FORBIDDEN APPLE raced close up inside under wraps, saved ground and finished gamely on the rail. STRUT THE STAGE was rated along outside, advanced three wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside. WITH ANTICIPATION was rated along inside, saved ground and had no rally, his rider losing his whip in upper stretch. BLAZING FURY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a solid finishing kick. HAP prompted the pace from the outside, could not stay with the winner entering the stretch and tired in the drive. SLEW THE RED was rated along outside and had no response when roused. KROMBACHER (GER) dropped back after the start and trailed throughout.
