BEAUTIFUL AMERICA raced close up early while well in hand, advanced three wide on the turn, responded when set down and drew away under a drive. HANSELINA raced in hand early on, came to the inside for the drive and rallied on the rail to earn the place award. THE NAME WAS GONE raced close up early, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and was outfinished for the place. HOT GOLDEN JET was outrun early, put in a four wide move on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. RAFFIE'S DREAM contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. BOARD ELLIGIBLE was outrun early, raced on the rail and tired in the stretch. AVE'S PRINCESSA had no response when roused. KINGS EMPRESS contested the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. DAVID'S DILEMMA raced wide and tired.
