FIZZANO quickly established command, carved the pace, under a firm hold, while racing along the inside, reached the five-sixteenths pole, with the runner up poised to strike, directly alongside, raced on nearly even terms with that one for the rest of the way around the bend, with both rider refusing to commit prematurely, got called upon after settling into upper stretch, as did STEHEN'S REVENGE, shook off that opponent during the run through the furlong grounds, then increased the winning margin, crossing the finish line under a vigorous hand ride. STEPHEN'S REVENGE patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, ranged up to look that one in the eye late on the far turn, kept pace until the quarter pole, sitting on reserve along with the top one, was put to encouragement in upper stretch, fell back slightly during the ensuing furlong, but continued on with good energy to procure the place. DESENFRENADO took the inside route, angled outward several paths spinning into the lane, was set to a hard drive once straightened away, and rallied to gain the show. FAST GRIEVANCE underwent a three wide journey and lacked the necessary stretch response. WRITETHATDOWN rated in the pocket, made an abbreviated run along the rail, flattened out during the last eighth. CIENTIFICO placed in the four path by the three-eighths pole, was let loose, attempting a four wide bid from the five-sixteenths pole, failed to sustain the move after entering the stretch. PIN settled into midpack soon after the start, kept pace with the front runners towards the two path, under a firm hold from the rider, continued to bide time, raced in traffic behind and amongst rivals from the five-sixteenths to the three-sixteenths pole, gained some room at that station, made little progress, attempting to kick in with little room to spare for the next eighth. WHEELER DEALER was taken off the inside departing the backstretch, turned for home four wide only to drift out an extra couple of paths, had no rally.
