Footnotes

SISTER BERTA contested the pace from the inside, without the rider needing to ask the mount, kicked clear of JUSTASMALLTOWNGIRL from midpoint on the turn, under her own power, turned for home with a comfortable advantage and maintained it, all while under her own courage, was let out approaching the eighth pole and held sway. MARIE'S BABE lost the pocket to another rival departing the backstretch, went on a bit more along the inside before being eased outward at the three-eighths pole. raced on the far turn with the rider applying a snug grip on the reins, angled to be four wide at the head of the stretch, got released from the previously described hold then finished with good energy from the outside to grab the place. LAKESIDE CHAPEL turned for home three wide and got out finished. MONTESSORI three wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. REAL GLORY wrested away the pocket from the runner up just past the half mile pole, was asked for some run on the turn, cut the corner into the lane, flattened out the last eighth. JUSTASMALLTOWNGIRL disputed the pace from the outside and gave way. MINT JULIET failed to reach contention, and was eased coming to the furlong marker.
