ROSE CATHERINE vied for the lead from the two path, racing head to head with BAILZEE directly to the inside, with the rider sitting aboard with a firm hold on the reins, shook free under her own power after turning for home, was given her cue coming to the eighth pole, then successfully fended off the late closers to preserve the decision. SEA ROAD broke with the field only to appear sluggish thereafter, dropped a good five lengths behind the nearest opponent at one point soon afterwards, settled into stride nearing the end of the backstretch and was guided over into the three path, spun wide into the lane and displayed a good kick to garner place honors. BECKY'S EXCHANGE tucked to the inside early down the backstretch, proved a bit slow to rate, anxiously fighting on the bit, particularly the right side of it, settled down and acted more professionally taking the inside route on the turn, was placed in the two path for the stretch drive and mustered up a good finish to grab the show. COMIC MARVEL bobbled at the break, sat under a firm hold for most of the way down the backstretch, was let out slightly soon after entering the turn, ranged up willingly three wide, turned for home and failed to gain ground appreciably. KARAKORUM ELEKTRA raced along the outside and lacked the needed response. BAILZEE disputed the pace from the inside until upper stretch, faltered.
