Footnotes

NOTE: NOTELL raced from well off the inside, drafted behind BONATINI into the stretch, was a few strides into the stretch drive before heading towards the five path in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, closed in on the front runners, reached even terms with less than sixteenth to go, took over and edged away in the final seventy yards under good handling. STRIKEALINETHRUIT unhurried for nearly a half, picked up interest heading for the top of the stretch, left the three-sixteenths marker from the seven path, came home with good energy to secure second. BONATINI raced four wide for most of the way around the bend, narrowed the gap during the run through the furlong grounds, came in slightly just as the former was likewise drifting outward slightly, unintentionally cutting off AKIRA and forcing the rider to steady, continued onward willingly to grab the show. STRAY BULLET squeezed at the start, underwent a ground-saving journey, unleashed a rail rally to loom a factor with an eighth to go, flattened out slightly in the late stages and had to settle for the last major check. SKIPS PROSPECT three wide entering the turn, was already under encouragement exiting it from the six path, mustered up a stretch response en route to earning minor spoils. CITY VICE off to a quick beginning, grabbed the early advantage and was sent over towards the inside, set the splits from

there, rated well and on a loosely-contested lead, came under heavier pressure late on the turn and was let out in response, had already drifted into the two path for the start of the stretch run, held his ground well during the run through the furlong grounds, despite continuing to drift towards the middle of the course, yielded past the eighth pole, came out one final time a sixteenth later, helping along with another to close down AKIRA's lane. NECESSARY LUXURY broke outward slightly at the start, rode the rail until midstretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. SHOT GUN PENNIE got brushed from between rivals at the start, angled to be five wide by the three-sixteenths pole, wasn't done maneuvering outward, to be wider still a short distance past that station, went fairly evenly for all the effort. AKIRA tracked the pacesetter while sitting a loose pocket, closed some of the gap during the later stages of the run around the bend, left the inside coming to the three-sixteenths pole and took off in earnest, was still in the fight for at least a major award when sandwiched by a pair of rivals, requiring the rider to steady off heels in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, understandably failed to regain interest thereafter. CITY SCAMPER underwent a three wide pursuit and folded. MOSTESS HOSTESS off the inside, tired. BEPPJ prompted the outside and gave way.
