Footnotes

FORTY TALES raced from off the inside, altered course towards the middle of the strip making his way through the furlong grounds, with the second place finisher following suit, tipped slightly wider to elude a wayward rival in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, and continued onward with good energy to get up late. DECLAN'S WARRIOR saved ground until nearing the quarter pole, angled outward under urging into the lane, followed the winner several more paths outward during the initial portion of the stretch drive, had CLEARLY NOW cross over in front with about a sixteenth remaining, altered to the inside without hardly missing a beat, got bothered by the same errant foe in the late stages for a second time, making some contact as a result right near the wire. CLEARLY NOW flipped up in the starting gate, causing a momentary delay, proceeded to come away without incident, sat forwardly placed three wide being rated, was switched over to a drive entering the stretch, came out, right in front of the rallying top twosome coming to the sixteenth pole, after receiving some left handed stickwork, had the pilot switch the stick to the opposite side, then drifted in slightly inward but enough to brush with the runner up in the shadow of the finish line. LET EM SHINE got away alertly and grabbed the advantage, steadily worked his way towards the inside, reaching the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, vied to maintained command with ZEE BROS pressing the issue just to his outside, arrived at the quarter

pole and was asked for run, as were all the closest pursuers, dug in stubbornly before getting in reeled in a few strides prior to the wire. ZEE BROS away to an alert beginning, maintained the forward position, prompted the pacesetter from the two path for a good portion of the way down the backstretch as well around the turn, was put to encouragement to challenge in earnest heading for the top of the lane, battled hard until near the sixteenth pole then weakened. TENANGO near the inside, got angled outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole, made an abbreviated run to reach contention with an eighth to go, couldn't sustain it and backed away. CAPO BASTONE devoid of early speed, swung five wide into the stretch and went on to improve position. HONORABLE DILLON raced along the outside and was no factor. SALUTOS AMIGOS tracked the front runners from the pocket, was called upon cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to pick up the pace and faltered. RETREIVE took an awkward first step inward leaving the starting gate, settled into the midpack and kept within range from the two path, was placed four wide for the commencement of the stretch, gave way. MERIT MAN departed the backstretch from the four path, was put to then flashed the whip from the right side completing the opening half, shortened stride noticeably shortly afterwards despite the rider's actions, drifted six wide into the stretch under a good hold and steadily retreated.
