YONAGUSKA was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, drew clear when roused and remained clear under a drive. THE GOO stumbled at the start, bumped YONAGUSKA after the start, came in while moving to the front on the backstretch, set the pace under pressure from the winner, proved no match for that rival in the stretch and continued on gamely to hold the place spot. CITY ZIP chased the pace along the inside and finished well on the rail. LIGHT OF JUSTICE was roughed up between rivals on the backstretch, raced wide and finished well outside. RICH COINS was roughed up between rivals on the backstretch, raced inside and lacked a rally. ENNIS was pinched back from between rivals on the backstretch, was steadied and had no rally. WRANGLER broke awkwardly, was bumped along the inside on the backstretch, put in a wide run approaching the stretch and tired in the drive. Following a stewards' inquiry concerning the start, the result was declared official.
