WILL HE SHINE showed good speed along the inside, enjoyed a clear journey on the rail, drew away when roused in upper stretch and was kept to the task to remain clear to the finish. SUAVE JAZZ was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside to earn the place. DASHBOARD DRUMMER was outrun early, raced inside and finished well while between rivals in the stretch. COUNCIL MEMBER was in hand while outrun early, raced inside and finished well on the rail. SIR FIVE STAR was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. JOEY P. was carried out into the turn, angled in on the turn, chased the pace and tired in the stretch. BORDONARO showed good speed outside, was carried wide on the turn and tired in the stretch. KEYED ENTRY flashed good speed from the start, bore out on the turn then bore out badly in the stretch.
