Footnotes

SENIORS PRIDE raced in midpack for a half, rallied four wide on the turn, drifted out after taking the lead in upper stretch and edged clear under right hand urging. MORE THAN A REASON was in hand along the rail, moved out midway on the turn, circled five wide at the quarter pole, made a run to threaten in midstretch but was no match for the winner. FUHREVER DANCING set the pace under pressure along the rail, moved out on the far turn, led to the top of the stretch and tired. UNBRIDLED DANGER angled to the rail while dueling on the far turn, battled into upper stretch and tired. FRENCH TRANSITION was reserved in the two path and lacked a rally. STEALTH MISSILE raced up close between horses, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and faltered. METULLA was outrun along the rail.
