BID A MOON left the backstretch four wide, steadily advanced in the right direction, the widest of all, during the run around the bend, was put to encouragement spinning into the lane, overtook JOONBI during the ensuing furlong to take charge, edged away under hand urging. JOONBI outward a bit at the break, was pulled off the nearest rival before making contact, was lightly hand urged to clear a tightly-packed bunch for the lead, got put to a good hold, once firmly in front, this occurring as she neared the end of the backstretch, continued to show the way slightly off the inside, turned for home, two wide and already under a drive, proved no match for the winner soon afterwards, relinquishing readily, but continued on with good courage to be second best. MARIA'S OWN underwent a three wide pursuit, proved no match for the top two twosome. SCOOTLES cut the corner under a full drive, angled to the middle of the strip in upper stretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. DATE TO REMEMBER gave chase from the outside, was through after completing a half. SHAY'S SLEW dropped back steadily and was eased coming to the eighth pole.
